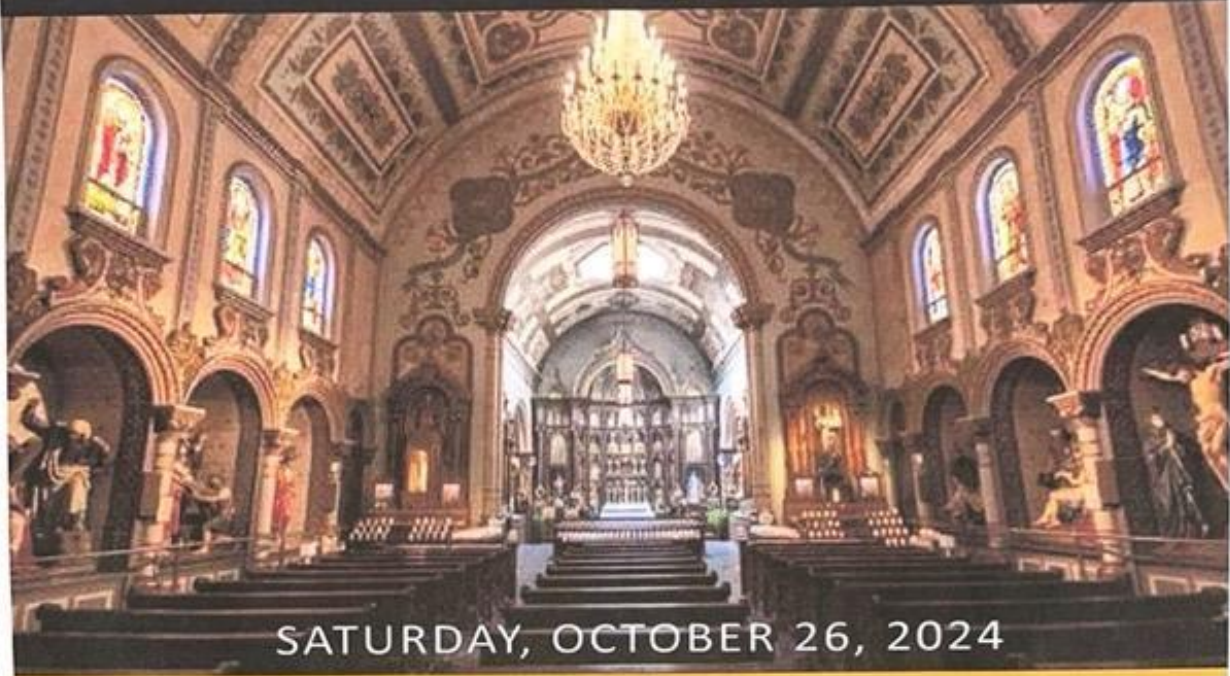

The registration is in place so we can get an idea of how many people to expect for the St. Brigid stop. We especially need to know since the Knights are providing the meat for the dinner.

I have received the following request from Father Blenman concerning the St. Brigid so far...

The Holy Eucharist is expected to arrive at 4:30pm on July 1st at the fairgrounds. There will be a Solemn Eucharistic Procession from the fairgrounds to St Brigid starting approximately 4:30pm. St. Brigid is requesting as many 4th degree in Regalia and as many Knights (3rd degree and below and 4th degrees that don't have the new Regalia) as possible in Knights clothing.

Once the Holy Eucharist arrives at St. Brigid Holy Hour will begin. During the first two hours (approximately 5:00-7:00pm) St. Brigid request the 4th degree in Regalia to provide watch for the Holy Eucharist. After their 2 hours and for the rest of the night the request is for at least 1 Knight in a pew during All-night vigil. This is so parishioners and guest will feel safe coming to the All Night Vigil at any time.

There will be community dinner. For the Knights we were asked to provide the meat for the dinner. Our Worthy Insurance team will be providing this however if they need help serving the meal the KofC will be there to provide to support.

At Approximately 6:00am St. Brigid request the 4th degree in Regalia to provide watch for the Holy Eucharist. This will last till approximately 7:30am when the All Night Vigil will end, and Holy Mass will begin.

After Holy Mass has ended there will be a Solemn Eucharistic Procession from St Brigid to Xenia Station. Just like the first Solemn Eucharistic Procession, St. Brigid is requesting as many 4th degree in Regalia and as many Knights (3rd degree and below and 4th degrees that don't have the new Regalia) as possible in Knights clothing.

We have been approved to have a table for growth at this event. I will be there as much as I can. If you like to help grow the order, please stop by.
